Re: General Info for Summer Junior Regions, East/West and National Championships

**** MEET DIRECTORS: BELOW IS ONLY A SET OF GUIDELINES, PLEASE READ THE RULEBOOK AND ANY AMENDMENTS OF THE RULEBOOK THOROUGHLY.**

Medals and Banners must be ordered for all competitions. Find ordering information on USA Diving's website. Please hang banners for the duration of the competition in a very visible location!

General Information

1. Throughout the year a diver MUST dive in his or her FINA-defined age group (i.e. his or her age on Dec. 31 of that year). A diver may continue to dive as a 16-18 year-old until he or she celebrates his or her 19th birthday.
2. Competition in each age group will be conducted in accordance with Articles 22, 24 and 26 in USA Diving's Rule Book. Divers should refer to the rules pertaining to the order of dives, DD requirements and lists of permissible dives for each age group.
3. The deadline for diving sheets is 12 noon on the day prior to the event at Region Championships, the East and West Junior National Championships and the Speedo Junior National Diving Championships. A fee of **\$15** may be assessed for those not meeting the sheet submission deadline. **A diver may make changes to his/her dive list up to three (3) hours prior to the start of an event, however, a \$15 fee will be imposed. It remains the diver's responsibility to conform to the competition parameters, such as degree of difficulty limits or minimums, and to satisfy dive group requirements. Divers will not be allowed to make changes to their dive lists within three (3) hours prior to the start of their event.**
4. **EACH DIVER MUST HAVE IN THEIR POSSESSION A CURRENT USA DIVING REGISTRATION NUMBER. COACHES MUST BE ON THE WEBSITE LIST OF CURRENT USA DIVING COACH MEMBERS TO BE ON THE POOL DECK. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS POLICY – IF UNREGISTERED DIVERS OR COACHES ARE ALLOWED ON DECK, ALL INSURANCE COVERAGE IS REVOKED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS!**

Summer Junior Regionals

****REGIONAL MEET DIRECTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FORWARDING ALL QUALIFIED DIVERS REGISTRATION FORMS TO THE EAST/WEST JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

1. Entry fee: **\$25 (\$12.50 per person for synchronized events)**

Entry forms and fees must be postmarked at least 8 days before the first day of the Regional Championships. Entries received after this deadline will be assessed a **\$25** penalty fee payable to the meet host.

2. Meet directors should **NOT MAKE** cuts at Regional Championships. However, if the projected finish time of the meet runs past dark in outdoor pools or unreasonably late into the evening, or if an unusual delay prevents timely completion of the meet, meet directors may impose cuts in the 14-15 and 16-18 events according to the following procedure:
 - (1) After all optionals and two voluntaries, if more than 24 divers, or
 - (2) After all optionals, if 40 or more divers.

There shall be no cuts in 11 & under and 13 & under events.

Junior East/West Championships

****EAST/WEST CHAMPIONSHIP MEET DIRECTORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FORWARDING ALL QUALIFIED DIVERS REGISTRATION FORMS TO THE JUNIOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

1. Entry fee: **\$25**

Divers that qualify for the Junior East/West Championships should refer to the Junior East/West Championships meet information sheets on USA Diving's website (www.usadiving.org) for instructions on how to enter these meets.

2. The eligibility requirements for the East/West Junior Diving Summer Championships are as follows:
 - A. The top eight finishers in a springboard event in a Regional Championship who are U.S. citizens shall be eligible to compete in that event only at the East/West Summer Championship, provided the diver has competed a full list of dives and not failed two or more dives. NOTE: 11 & under is for Region Championships only. Divers must enter 13 & under, 14-15 or 16-18 to qualify for the East/West Championships.
 - B. Should one of the eight qualifiers from the Regional Championships be unable to participate in an East/West Summer Championships, the Regional Meet Director shall designate the next finalist in order of finish in that event to complete the eight qualifiers for that event. No diver who finishes below 12th place shall be eligible.
 - C. In the event of a tie for eighth place, nine divers may advance to an East/West Summer Championship, but only if all nine choose to compete. Finalists finishing below eighth place may only be designated as East/West Summer qualifiers to make up the full complement of eight qualifiers allocated to a Regional meet.
 - D. One male and one female diver per age group, registered and training in the states of Alaska and Hawaii may compete without attending a Regional Championship Meet. These divers must be designated by the Chair of their Association and submit their qualifications to the Junior Rules Subcommittee Chair no less than 30 days prior to the East/West Summer Championships.
 - E. Platform events at the East/West Championships: Those divers who do not qualify on springboard, but will be attending the East/West Championships for platform will need to register 8 days prior to the East/West Championships. For Platform events, the minimum total of degrees of difficulty for optional dives shall be:
 - (1) 13 & Under 6.4
 - (2) 14 – 15 girls 7.2 (list must show five groups)
 - (3) 14 – 15 boys 9.6 (list must show five groups)
 - (4) 16 – 18 girls 9.6 (list must show five groups)
 - (5) 16 – 18 boys 12.5 (list must show six groups)
 - F. Even though the summer regionals do not include qualifying events for platform competition, any diver who is a U.S. citizen may submit an entry to dive in the platform event at the East/West Summer Championships. A diver who competes in a regional competition is only eligible to compete in the East or West Summer Championship determined by the regional meet in which the diver participated. This restriction applies even if a diver fails to qualify for springboard competition from the regional meet to an East or West Summer Championship. Those divers who only dive platform and do not attend any Regional Championships may attend either East or West Summer Championships.

Junior National Championships

1. Entry fee: **\$25**

Divers that qualify for the Junior National Championships are automatically entered, but must pay an entry fee at the meet site.
2. The eligibility requirements for the Junior National Diving Championships are as follows: Any diver who is a U.S. citizen and meets one of the following standards for an event is eligible to compete in the Junior National Championships.
 - (1) From each East/West Summer Championship meet, divers who finish in places **one** through **12** shall qualify for the preliminaries of the Junior National Championships in that event only (USA Diving's junior subcommittee and rules chairman confirmed this qualification procedures, which takes the place of rule 126.1 e (1) and (2) in USA Diving's 2006-2007 rule book) .
 - (2) Should one of the qualifiers from the East/West Summer Championships be unable to participate in the U.S. Junior National Championships, the Meet Director of the East/West Summer Championship Meet shall contact the next finalist in order of finish in that event to complete the twelve qualifiers for that event. No diver who finishes below sixteenth place shall be considered.
3. **Divers will perform a full list of dives in the preliminaries. The top 12 divers will move on to the finals where optional dives only will be performed (the voluntary dive scores from the preliminaries will carry over into the finals).**

USA Diving Code, ARTICLE 90 - Anti-Doping

690.1 United States Anti-Doping Agency Protocol Compliance

(a) **General.** As a member of National Governing Body of the U.S. Olympic Committee (“USOC”) and a member of FINA, United States Diving Inc. is obligated to adhere to the anti-doping rules of the USOC and FINA. In addition, USOC Bylaw Chapter XXIII, Section 2(G) provides that, as a condition of membership in the USOC, each National Governing Body shall comply with the procedures pertaining to drug testing and adjudication of related doping offenses of the independent anti-doping organization designated by the USOC to conduct drug testing. The USOC has designated the U.S. Anti-Doping Agency (“USADA”) as that organization.

(b) **Athlete responsibilities.** It is the responsibility of the each athlete member of USA Diving to comply with the anti-doping rules of FINA, USOC and USADA. It is also the responsibility of each athlete member of USA Diving to submit without reservation or condition, to in-competition and out-of-competition doping controls conducted by either FINA or USADA. (Out-of competition testing of athletes may take place at elite-level camps, training sessions at USOC facilities, or at any other designated events. No advance notice testing of athletes may take place at any time for those athletes designated by USA Diving and USADA for inclusion in USA Diving’s no-advance-notice testing pool.)

(c) **Affectivity.** Pursuant to USOC Bylaws Chapter XXIII, Section 2(G), the management of positive and elevated test results (after Oct. 2, 2000) for United States Diving Inc.’s athletes have become the responsibility of USADA. Any inconsistent provisions elsewhere in this Code are hereby superseded. USA Diving without further process, enforce and publish any sanction communicated to USA Diving by USADA resulting from adjudication of a doping control under the USADA Protocol.

In signing below, I hereby give my consent to be tested at any time for banned substances in accordance with the rules of USD, USOC, and FINA.
